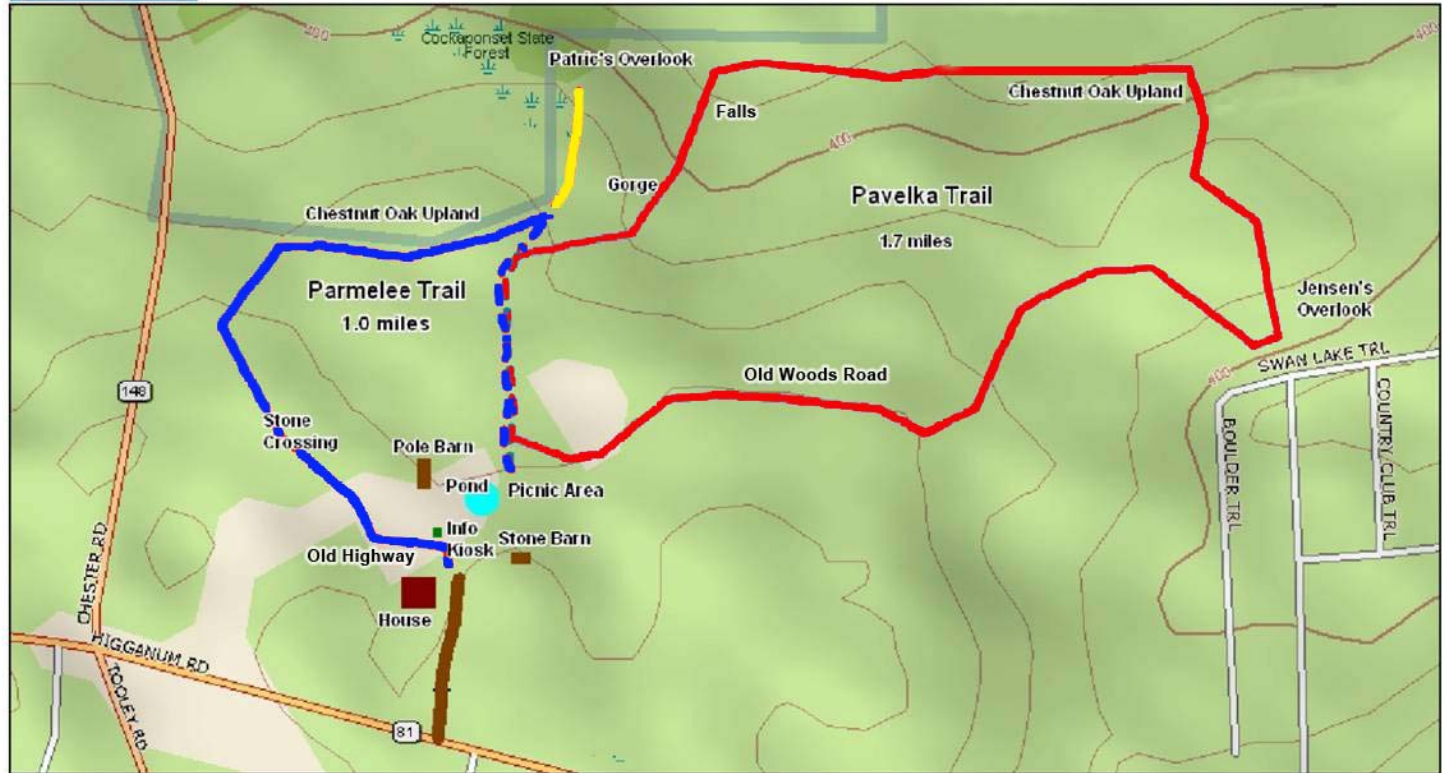


PARMELEE FARM TRAILS

Location: The trails are located on the Parmelee Farm property located at 465 Route 81. The farm is just one-tenth of a mile south of the intersection with Route 148, and 1.8 miles north of Route 80 – just north of the H-K Middle School. The driveway is on the east side, marked with a sign. There is a gate. If locked, there is parking at the first lot at the H-K Middle School, with a short trail to Parmelee which starts east of the lot just past the crosswalk.

Length/Difficulty: The Parmelee Trail is one mile in length, and the Pavelka Trail is 1.7 miles long. Each can be done as an individual loop. There is little climbing and the walks are suitable for families and are usually dry.



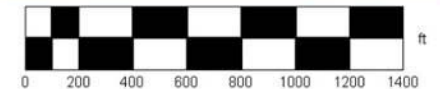

Trail Description: The Parmelee Trail is blazed in blue; the Pavelka Trail is blazed in red. The shared section is blue/red and the trail spur to Patric’s Overlook is yellow. The Parmelee Trail starts to the left of the kiosk and includes a stone crossing and a woods overlook. The Pavelka Trail can be accessed via a small bridge near the pond, crosses through a field, includes an overlook by Jensens, Inc. Adult Community and parallels a stream and gorge.

Restrictions: No motorized vehicles at any time. Dogs must be on a leash or under the control of their owners.
